Call to Order

Bryony opened the meeting at 6:00 pm. Attendees introduced themselves. Bryony requested that each attendee complete the sign-in sheet.

Discuss and Rank 2009-11 Watershed Implementation Grant Requests

Bryony noted that she received nine sets of rankings for the five Watershed Implementation grant requests (all operational projects). Bryony said that she averaged the scores from the nine completed forms and developed an average ranking for the proposed projects. Bryony provided the average ranking to those present in a handout. The ranking based on the nine completed forms is listed in the table below:

Hank asked if a proposed project cost of \$400,000 for the Nine Mile Point Source Study Phase 1 (i.e., a relatively large cost) would be viewed as a negative by Ecology. Sara said it possibly could and that there is much less money available this biennium for operational funds. Mike noted that he worked with TetraTech staff to scope the first phase of the Nine Mile Point Source Study and that the scope covers items that would need to be completed first.

Those present agreed with the project ranking. Mike will add the rankings to the application forms and pass the completed forms on to Ecology.

Cynthia Carlstad (TetraTech) asked those present to make sure that they had the following handouts:

Cynthia noted that she will be going through the recommendations sections of the working draft Watershed Plan on the screen at this meeting and hopes to obtain consensus on suggested edits. Cynthia noted that the group will not be working with the implementation matrix tonight.

Rob Lindsay said that he would like the Planning Unit to the keep the number of recommendations to a manageable level and to recognize the difference between a recommendation and a suggested action to implement a recommendation.

Cynthia Carlstad worked with the group on suggested edits to the recommendations, starting on page 4-2 of the October 2008 working draft Watershed Plan. Those present discussed the major comments received and suggested edits on the recommendations for Chapter 4 (Water Rights Administration), Chapter 5 (Promoting Efficient Use of Water), Chapter 6 (Providing Water for Future Needs), Chapter 7 (Water Storage Opportunities) and Chapter 8 (Integrating Land Use and Water Supply Planning). Those present came to agreement on how to address the comments and Cynthia captured the change that was agreed to by the group on the electronic version of the working draft Watershed Plan (which was projected on to the screen).

The group agreed to the following review schedule for the marked-up version of the October 2008 draft Watershed Plan:
